GROUND REGULATIONS

All persons entering the Stadium on match days are only admitted subject to these rules and regulations:

- 1) The Club reserves the right to eject from the ground and prosecute, if thought appropriate, any person within the clubs premises who is considered in breach of the following: **a)** Entering the ground by any means other than through the proper turnstiles or gates. **b)** Entering the field of play before, during or after the game. **c)** Using obscene or abusive language or persistent swearing likely to cause offence. **d)** Using terms of abuse, racial or otherwise, that is likely to offend. **e)** Being drunk or being under the influence of drugs. **f)** Making vulgar or obscene gestures. **g)** Carrying any offensive object or throwing any article onto the field of play.
- 2) The Club reserves the right to refuse admission or eject from the ground any person who refuses to be searched by any servant or agent of the club or any Police Officer.
- 3) No glass bottles, drinking glasses or other such article or object is permitted in the ground and the Club Officials / Stewards will have the right to seize or confiscate any item or article considered to be a danger to others.
- 4) Climbing of the fences, stands and other structures including sitting on the barriers around the pitch is not permitted.
- 5) All vehicles are parked at the owner's risk.
- 6) Only players, officials and club personnel may enter the changing room area.
- 7) No Smoking or Alcohol allowed on school grounds.

Last week we won away at Leiston U23's 8-1 however the official FA and League sites all show 7-1. Apparently the Referee put 7 on his match report. Lets hope a goal difference of one is not a factor at the end of the season. Anyway we move on.

Our last home game here was a very tight encounter against a Harwich & Parkeston side that would have leapfrogged us in the table had they won. The game finish 2-2 with Harwich scoring a last minute penalty. I think the Harwich goal frame deserved Man of the Match but as we couldn't finish a draw so probably fair.

The Reserves are away at Belle Vue today and having had 2 defeats they look to get back to winning ways. Although it is good to win the reserves is not all about winning but rather individual players performing well enough to get in to the first team squad.

After today we look forward to a massive week for the club. Tomorrow the Ladies first team are away at St Albans in the League Cup, 1.30pm while the Ladies reserves are away at Island Ladies from Canvey.

Wednesday evening we travel to Billericay Town, it is a nice ground with cover on all sides and a 4g pitch so we should have no weather concerns as we play a League Cup tie against Hutton. Hutton are flying high just 3 points off the top of the Thurlow Nunn South Division. As they were promoted last season this will be the first meeting between the clubs.

Then its the big one. Next Saturday we have arguably the biggest game in the history of Stanway Pegasus in the 2nd Round of the FA Vase. (although some would say last seasons play off final)

Having beaten Haverhill Borough, Takeley and Halstead Town we face Barkingside here, 3pm. Barkingside have played here twice before, on October 3rd they beat us 2-1 in the Essex County Cup and last season in a league fixture we drew 2-2. Third time lucky? See you all next week.

IN OPPOSITION :

NORWICH CBS



The club was formed in 1888 as the works team of Norwich Union.

They became members of the Norwich & District Business House League and were Division One champions in 1926–27, 1946–47 and 1947–48.

The club then moved up to the East Anglian League, entering Division One in 1955.

When the league merged with the Norfolk & Suffolk League to form the Anglian Combination in 1964, the club became members of Section A of the new league.

Norwich Union were Premier Division runners-up in 1987–88, before winning the division the following season.

After winning the Norfolk Junior Cup in 1998–99 they were Division Two champions in 1999–2000.

In 2002–03 the club were promoted back to the Premier Division. After becoming AFC Norwich in 2008, in 2009 they were renamed Spixworth after relocating to the village.

They won the league's Mummery Cup in 2010–11 and 2014–15 and were runners-up in the Premier Division in 2012–13, 2013–14 and 2015–16.

In 2016–17 the club won the Premier Division title, earning promotion to Division One of the Eastern Counties League. They were then renamed Norwich CBS after relocating to Bowthorpe.

Ground

The club played at Pinebanks in Thorpe St Andrew until 2008.

After a year at Dussindale the club moved to Crotswick Lane in Spixworth

in 2009.

In 2017 Spixworth Parish Council informed the club that it was no longer able to use the ground, resulting in them relocating to the Football Development Centre in Bowthorpe.

Stanway Pegasus Football Club was derived from the most successful Sunday League side in Colchester history, AFC Pegasus, who won an incredible 64 honours over a period of 30 years with Paul and Heather Booth at the helm for every one of them.

AFC Pegasus in turn was created from Pegasus Youth in 1985 who had a great history in the Colchester Youth League for many years dating back to the early 1970's with the founder being Mr Peter Peters.

When Paul and Heather stepped aside a new era was about to begin and the transition from Sunday League to Saturday football for the senior team in 2018 opened the door for the return of the youth set up at the club.

With passion and drive to succeed than ever before, both off and off the pitch, we were ready to start that new era. With various youth and men's teams in full swing, our vision is to be one of the biggest clubs in Essex that has men's teams competing at a high level of non-league football who lead the way for the youth set-up. This youth set-up will progress through their age groups starting at U6's, all the way through to U18's.

This is what we call 'The Pathway'. Although player development is a key aspect of our philosophy, the aim for the youth is to enjoy playing football for Stanway Pegasus and looking at the talented home grown youth squads we have, boys and girls the future

is looking very good under the guidance of our Head of Youth Ray Turner.

The Club prides itself hugely on former and current players plus youth managers taking up major roles within the Club whilst surrounding ourselves with people we trust.

Soon to be added to the Pegasus family were the women, girls and recently the Vets as the club proudly sits at over 30 teams have been the fastest growing Club in the area and success is no stranger with many league titles and promotions along with cup success the Club is blossoming into a huge success story and long may it continue.

Senior football for the men's first team was secured for the first time at the end of the 2021 /22 season with the team gaining promotion from Essex and Suffolk Border Premier League where they went unbeaten winning the league with 98 points from 34 games scoring 126 goals in the process.

They also beat Tiptree Heath 1-0 in the League Cup Final at Little Oakley. Max Booth was the Division's top goal scorer with 34 (26 league and 8 Cup)

2022/23 Season saw the team in the Eastern Counties Division One South where we narrowly lost out on promotion at the first attempt via a penalty shoot out after a 2-2 draw against Sporting Bengal.

Although heartbreaking at the time looking back and what a

debut season for the club in senior football. Callum Griffith was the Division's top goal scorer with 32 (29 league and 3 Cup / Play offs)



Rosi Webb (Pictured) has been a revelation for our club during this period being the Men's 1st team manager while also playing in the successful ladies' teams she is Mrs Pego and quite rightly getting the accolades she deserves.

2023/24 Season has seen the Men's first team moved sideways from the Eastern Counties Division One South division to the North division while the Men's Reserve team are competing in the Essex and Suffolk Border League's Premier Division.

The ladies have been just as successful in a short period of time with winning the Essex County Women's Premier League piping by 2 points local rivals Stanway Rovers to seal back to back promotions that now see them competing in the Eastern Region League for the first time as the club looks to push on in all fronts.

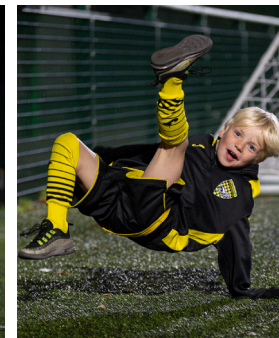
A Ladies reserve team started up and joined the Essex County Women's League Division 3 for the 2023/24 season.
